Tucson Medical Center Announce Winners in Raffle Appreciation Phase TMC Mega Raffle awards first 12 prizes

TUCSON, ARIZ. - (Feb. 13, 2014) – Southern Ariz. won in more ways than one on Wednesday, Feb. 12.
